What will happen?



After the agent has added your farm business details into Bayer's seed portal, you will receive an email containing a link to the Bayer website to view their terms and conditions.

A simple click accepts/declines terms & conditions (you only need to do this once, for your first order).

You will receive an email from Bayer confirming acceptance of T&Cs and receipt of your seed order.

The agent delivers the seed and is responsible for collection of payment.
